- ☆ The nominee's community work must have been conducted, started or completed between September 1, 2008 and August 31, 2009.
- ☆ Nominees should be able to document the results of their individual involvement through published reports and/or testimonials from the organization they served.
- ☆ Applications must contain **THREE** copies of the entry form and any backup documentation.
